We have begun work on leveling many of the drain grates around the course to help in draining off excess water, as well as, making some of these areas more playable. We have also started probing the bunkers to see how much sand they have in them, as well as, the condition of the sand. Many of the bunkers we have checked have plenty of sand in them, however it has accumulated in the low lying end of the bunker and needs to be redistributed through out the bunker. We will continue to make a list of bunkers that do not have sufficient sand in them and prioritize those that need it the most.

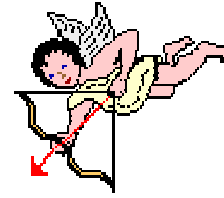
