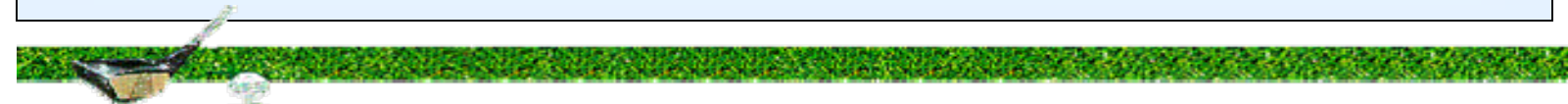

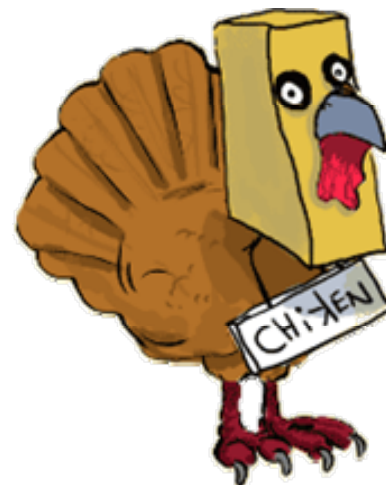

Right now we are working on bunker edging as well as the cart paths before the grass is completely dormant. Soon will come the yearly task of blowing and sweeping up the leaves as they fall across the property. The tees on the course have been overseeded and as soon as the plant is strong enough we will start mowing them. Also we have replanted the fescue areas between #18 and #12 as well as #7. We have these areas roped off presently to help establish the grass. We would like to thank everyone in advance for their help in staying out of these areas while in a golf cart.
